**10th IWAS WORLD JUNIOR GAMES 2014, Stoke
Mandeville, Great Britain - 2 to 8 August**



Thank you to all the Nations for your overwhelming support. To date IWAS has received entries from 25 Nations - 250 competitors and 150 staff expressing their interest to attend the games at Stoke Mandeville, the birthplace of the Paralympic Movement.

If any Nation did not return the first entry form, the opportunity to enter the Games is still open. Accommodation might be more costly than advertised if teams do not want to stay in the dormitory accommodation at Stoke Mandeville as we have limited accommodation on-site.

All 8 sports: Archery, Athletics, Wheelchair Fencing, Powerlifting, Shooting, Swimming, Table Tennis and Paratriathlon received entries and we shall keep them all on the programme. *We do however retain the right to cancel a sport should the numbers in the final entries make the sport not viable to put on.* We shall also have Para-Taekwondo as a demonstration sport and as it's been shortlisted for 2020 Paralympic status I am sure it will be of interest to all.

Attached is the Final Entry pack with updated information and the spreadsheet to complete in detail. Full payment must be submitted to IWAS to make entries official and final. No Visa letters will be distributed if payment has not been received and financial details are in the information package.

The deadline for submitting Final Entry Forms is **25 June 2014**. Please adhere to this date because we have to submit names to IFs for classification verification and also for accommodation reservations it is essential to have this information.

PLEASE NOTE: For results to be recognised by the IPC Sports

(This is not a requirement for entering the Games – only for IPC results and record recognition)

Athletes must be licensed by IPC before the start of the competition. IPC Licensed athletes must have a valid, current, IPC Review or Confirmed International Classification to be eligible to have their results recognised by IPC for the purposes of rankings, records and qualification for future events.

Accreditation Card Process

Entry forms should be submitted by e-mail. Each member of the Delegation must submit a photo. Photos must be of passport size, taken within the last 6 months. Photos can be sent electronically – preferably in *.JPG format.

Flag and National Anthem

Nations are requested to provide IWAS with an electronic copy of both their National Flag and Anthem or the link to a website from where the correct information can be downloaded.

ONLY 30 seconds of National Anthems will be played during medal ceremonies. Nations have the option to provide IWAS with a 30 sec recording of their preferred part of their anthem. If IWAS has to shorten the National Anthem we shall record the first 30 seconds of the Anthem.

This information is required by 25/06/2014.

Media Contacts

To ensure that every Nations obtains the maximum exposure for their team, we request that teams provide the IWAS office with contact details of Media contacts in their respective countries to whom press and media information about the Games can be send beforehand and during the Games.

Refund Policy

70% Refund: Athletes and Staff who withdraw from the IWAS World Games will receive a 70% refund until 26/06/2014

No-Refund: After the 27 June 2014 no entry fee will be refunded.

Athlete Replacement/Substitution: Nations can replace/substitute competitors of the same gender, class and event for those that have to withdraw for whatever reason up to 3 weeks (12/07/2014) before the start of the games.

Doping controls: The IWAS doping rules apply. Athletes can be tested for doping at any time, during or out of competition.

Insurance: Competitors have to provide insurance for their own accident and liability. The organiser excludes any liability and assumes no responsibility for loss or theft of materials or personal belongings during the games.

Conclusion: All participants have the duty to observe safety regulations and other regulations of the organiser. **The TD reserves the right to make changes in the schedule.**
