



Memorandum of Understanding

For the promotion of Para-Taekwondo between the **World Taekwondo Federation (WTF)** and the **International Wheelchair and Amputee Sports Federation (IWAS)**

The World Taekwondo Federation and the International Wheelchair and Amputee Sports Federation hereby agree to the following for the promotion of Para-Taekwondo among amputee and wheelchair athletes.

- WTF and IWAS agree that Para-Taekwondo Kyorugi for Athletes with amputee or limb deficiency are to be included in an IWAS-recognized event at the 5th WTF World Para-Taekwondo Championships to be held in 2014; WTF agrees to invite representatives from IWAS to attend these Championships
- IWAS will actively contribute to the development of Para-Taekwondo Classification that shall include wheelchair and amputee/limb deficiency athletes;
- IWAS will actively contribute to the development of Para-Taekwondo Poomsae for wheelchair and amputee athletes;
- The WTF agrees to promote Para-Taekwondo Kyorugi and Poomsae for wheelchair and amputee/limb deficiency athletes among its 205 Member National Associations;
- WTF and IWAS agree to cooperate to examine what modifications to the field of play and competition regulations, procedures and classification system to best serve the development of Para-Taekwondo in competition between wheelchair and amputee/limb deficiency athletes, implementing any modifications in a standardized fashion where possible;
- WTF and IWAS will encourage respective national associations to work together for the promotion of Para-Taekwondo;
- WTF and IWAS agrees to the inclusion of Para-Taekwondo as a demonstration competition in the 2014 10th IWAS World Junior Games in Stoke Mandeville, Great Britain;
- WTF agrees to continue developing Para-Taekwondo to fulfill all requirements for inclusion on the program of the 2015 IWAS World Games
